Event Registration:

2026 SKC Supplementary Regulations

23. REGULATIONS THAT MUST BE SPECIFIED IN THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS TO APPLY

ADD:

Auxiliary Lighting is Permitted

Drivers may install auxiliary lights on their karts for the Night Race, provided they meet the following requirements:



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- **Steady illumination only.** Lights may not strobe, pulse, blink, flash, or use changing light patterns.
- **Self-powered.** Lights must operate from an independent battery/power source and may not be connected to the kart's engine or electrical system.
- **Securely mounted.** Lights, batteries, and wiring must be securely attached and must not interfere with kart operation or driver movement.
- **No glare.** Lights must not be aimed directly toward drivers, marshals, corner workers, officials, or stewards.
- **No obstruction.** Lighting must not obstruct the driver's vision or prevent officials from clearly observing the kart and track.
- **No interference with race signals.** Lights must not imitate, obscure, or interfere with official flags, lights, or other race signals.

Official Approval

All lighting installations are subject to technical inspection.

Officials may require any light to be repositioned, covered, disabled, or removed if it creates a safety, visibility, or distraction concern.

The Race Director and Technical Officials have final authority regarding the suitability of any lighting installation.

When in doubt, ask a Technical Official before going on track.

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
